

## Installation instructions

Tall Boys

**Tools required** (good excuse to buy more tools)

- 1. Metric Hex tools 4mm, 5mm, 6mm (Sockets and T-handles)
- 2. Torque wrench (range between 8Nm 35Nm)

## Installation

- 1. First note the position of the cables and wires then start to loosen controls, throttle, brake and clutch.
- 2. Remove left side grip.
- 3. Loosen triple clamp pinch bolts and carefully remove top triple clamp.
  - a) If your bike has clip-ons stock, loosen stock clip-on pinch bolts and remove stock clip-ons. Leave controls and levers on the stock clip-ons until you are ready to swap.
  - b) If your bike has handlebars stock, separate handlebar from triple clamp. Leave controls and levers on the stock clip-ons until you are ready to swap.
- 4. **IMPORTANT:** apply grease or anti seize to the mating surface of locating boss between riser and clamp to ensure proper fit and seating of components! See DETAIL A on the exploded view.
- 5. You can now install the Tall Boys onto the fork clamps and position. Apply a little blue Locktite to all hardware.
- 6. **Important**: Before moving on, torque the four large M8x20mm bolts that hold the risers to the fork clamps. Torque these bolts to 34 Newton meters.
- 7. Re-install top triple clamp and torque bolts to factory recommended specs.
- 8. For easy installation of the controls, we recommend clipping or filing off the locating pins from the controls and throttle housing.
- 9. Swap controls from old clip-ons to new Omni Bars and slide into the Tall Boys, keep everything loose.
- 10. You can now start to position everything.
  - a) Take your time and be patient.
  - b) It is nice to have a helping hand at this point.
  - c) Check clearance often and don't be afraid to re-adjust.
  - d) You may need to change the cable and wire routing.
  - e) You may need to adjust steering stops.
- **11.**When you are satisfied with the position, tighten everything down and set torque to the recommended settings. See exploded view for Tall Boys torque settings.
