

- 2 Aluminum Velocity stacks
- 2 K&N Air filters
- Coil Bracket
- Hardware installation kit
- Crank case breather kit
- Idle air filter kit (when applicable)
- 1. When starting this installation you want to make sure you fuel tank is half empty or less.
 - a. This will make it a lot easy to work with tank.
- 2. Make sure the bike has had plenty of time to cool down.
- 3. Remove the seat and tank from the bike.
- 4. Disconnect negative battery terminal.
- 5. Remove the airbox drain hose.
 - a. You can remove this entirely from the bike as you won't be re-using it.
- 6. Disconnect the spark plug wires and plugs from the coil mounted to the airbox.
 - a. Note where the plug wires come from so they can be re-installed correctly.
- 7. Remove the air box.
 - a. There is a screw under the box towards the front. There are also the two nipples that will pull directly up. There are clamps for each throttle intake, loosen those as well.
 - b. Remove each coil that is mounted to the airbox.
- 8. Remove the metal spacer and grommet from the front mounting tab from the airbox.
- 9. Remove crank case breather tube
- 10. Remove the nipples from the bottom of the airbox
- 11. Mount the nipples the coil bracket with the provided M6 size nyloc nuts
- 12. Mount the coil the bracket using the provided bolt/washer/nut.



13. Remove the idle air vacuum tube from the throttle bodies.



- 14. Install the new air idle vacuum line and clamp it at the throttle bodies
- 15. Fit the coil bracket and secure vacuum line with clamp



- 16. Install the idle air filter on top of the coil bracket.
- 17. Mount the front coil using the provided clamps and hardware



18. Install the velocity stacks in to the filters.



19. Install the crank case breather filter.
